At Inveralmond Community High School, we recognise the need to reduce the cost of the school day for all our young people, and particularly those who are experiencing poverty.

Getting Dressed for School

At the school we have a dress code policy and consulted with parents and pupils. The items in the dress code can be bought in high street stores/supermarkets at a reasonable price. Travel to School

The majority of our pupils walk to school. Many have taken advantage of the Government Free Travel Incentive. Transport is provided for curriculum related courses including college and bespoke timetables. Information on travel can be found on our website.

Learning at School and at Home

There is no additional cost applied to learning, including practical subjects like Home Economics, Art and Craft and Design Technologies. Our departments can provide books, jotters, pencils, pens, rulers and calculators at no extra cost to parents.





School Trips

At Inveralmond we try to plan trips that are local and have no or a small cost. Other trips have a clear cost and are planned in advance with payment schedules and financial support may also be available. No pupils will be disadvantaged through affordability.

Fun Events & Charity Events

We plan events at regular points throughout the year that are free of charge to pupils and parents. We promote random acts of kindness, in line with our school values. A calendar is shared at the start of each school session to support cost planning. Donations optional.





School Canteen - Invy Eats

Promotion of Free School Meals to families at events throughout the year and we have Family Link Workers who can support families to apply. Our menu is good value for money and we have a cashless lunch system reducing stigma. We also operate a breakfast club offering breakfast items at very low cost.
