The deadline for the first wave of college applications is set for March 1st 2024. Please note that applications will close promptly on this date. Any applications received after March 1st 2024 will automatically be rolled over to the following second wave.

Interviews will be exclusively offered to successful applicants. For the 1st wave, Interviews are scheduled for Thursday, March 14th. Only students with successful applications will be eligible for interviews. Any students who arrive on the interview day without a prior application will be redirected back to school.

The deadline for wave 2 has been set for April 19th, with interview dates to be confirmed and the deadline for wave 3 applications is May 17th, with interview dates to be confirmed.

Please ensure timely submission of applications and adhere to the outlined deadlines.
